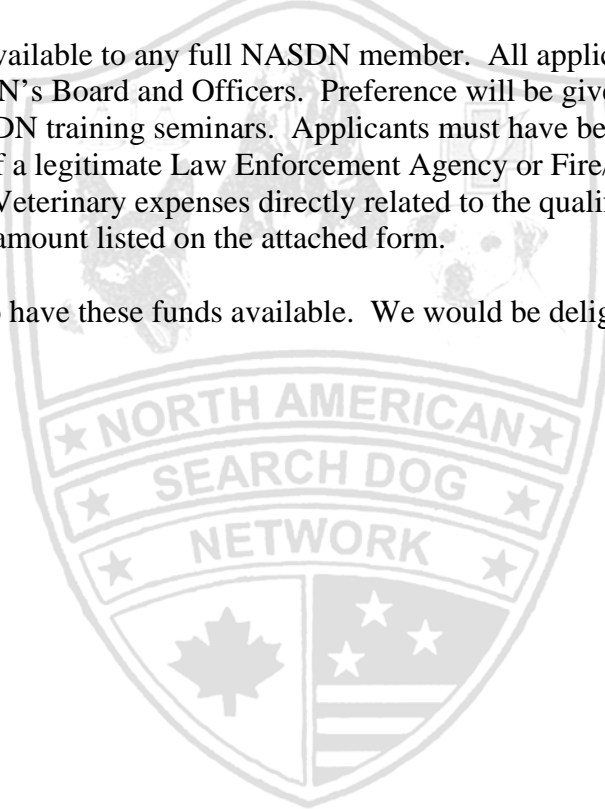


The Luke Fund

The Luke fund was established by Mary McCormick, DMV, in memory of her K9 partner Luke. This fund awards grants to assist with veterinary expenses resulting from injuries a Search Dog receives during actual working activities.

The Luke Fund is available to any full NASDN member. All applications must be approved by NASDN's Board and Officers. Preference will be given to members who have attended NASDN training seminars. Applicants must have been working with their dog at the request of a legitimate Law Enforcement Agency or Fire/Rescue Agency at the time of the injury. Veterinary expenses directly related to the qualifying injury must meet the minimum amount listed on the attached form.

NASDN is happy to have these funds available. We would be delighted if they were never needed.
